Time capsules

Artist Lori Putnam says a painting is like a “time capsule.”

“It’s about interpreting a moment, capturing the light’s ever-changing effects, and translating all of that to the canvas for others to experience,” says Putnam.

The artist seeks to express the effects of light, mood and atmosphere that surround seemingly ordinary objects, hoping that viewers may see something in a way they have never witnessed it before.

“I am not interested in painting ‘nouns,’” says Putnam. “Most anyone can learn to follow a formula and produce a fairly decent rendering of a person, place, or thing. Rather, I am interested in capturing ‘adjectives and adverbs;’ the person’s character, interpreting the feeling of the place, or expressing the detailed effects of light.”

Putnam, a Signature Member of

International Plein Air Painters, has exhibited in many prestigious venues including the Salmagundi Club in New York and in the national and the eastern regional exhibitions of the Oil Painters of America. Her works are in the permanent collection at The Academy Art Museum in Easton, Maryland, in private collections, and in galleries worldwide.

“Putnam’s paintings have a soft, dream-like, magical quality, the kind that invites the viewer to enter the scene, smell the air, feel the relentless heat of the sun,” says collector Eva Hegedus of Philadelphia.
